

BGC Playoff Policy

- Preference is to start playoff on a hole with a handicap of 5 thru 14 if possible.
- Strokes given will be determined by stroking off the low participant.

Two Person Playoff

Strokes given will be as follows (regardless of the hole handicap)

Handicap Differential	Strokes
0 - 5	No strokes
6 - 9	Stroke on every other hole - start without stroke
10 - 13	Stroke on every other hole - start with stroke
14 - 23	Stroke every hole
24 - 27	One or two strokes every other hole - start with one stroke
28 and up	One or two strokes every other hole - start with two strokes

More than Two Person Playoff

The above chart will also be used for a playoff of more than 2 players, with the following modified rules:

- If there are multiple players with a handicap differential of between 6 and 13 from the low handicap, all players with a handicap differential between 6 and 13 from the low handicap player will play with the same strokes on each hole. A coin flip will determine if all the 6-13 handicap players will get a stroke on the first playoff hole or not.
- If there are multiple players with a differential of 24 or above from the low player, all players with a differential of 24 and up will play with the same strokes on each hole. A coin flip will determine if all the 24 and up players get 1 or 2 strokes on the first playoff hole.
- If there are both 6-13 and 24 and above differential players in the 3 player or more playoff, the 24 and above players will get one more stroke each hole from the 6-13 players. The 6-13 players strokes for each hole will be determined first.
